**Questions and Answers**

**1. Are classes cancelled? When are classes resuming?**

All classes (theory and practicum) in Florida (except for Fort Lauderdale) are cancelled until Monday, October 3, 2022. Classes are scheduled to resume on Monday, October 3, 2022 at 6:30 a.m. The resumption of classes is conditioned on the campuses having electricity. The College will provide updates via our traditional channels (SchoolCast, website, and/or social media) with regards to additional closures (e.g., on or after Monday, October 3, 2022).

**2. Will cancelled class time be made up? Are exams being rescheduled?**

The education department is reviewing the current schedules for each program and will provide updated course schedules in the near future to address missed time and rescheduled exams (as needed).

**3. My home is without power, where can I get support?**

To the extent that the campuses have power, we plan on opening the facilities for our students and their families starting Friday, September 30, 2022. The facilities may be used for recharging of electronic equipment, internet access (where available), and general support during these hours. The facilities are not available for overnight use. While on campus, students and their families are expected to conduct themselves in a professional and orderly manner. Masks will not be required; however, we recommend that masks be worn while at the campus. In addition, students do not need to wear their uniform during these days.
