ENROLLMENT AT JERSEY COLLEGE IS REQUIRED TO APPLY FOR THE NURSING MISSION TRIP PURSUANT TO THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS SET FORTH BELOW. ALL FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL, AND MUNICIPAL LAWS AND REGULATIONS APPLY. VOID WHERE PROHIBITED.

- 1. Nursing Mission Selection:** Jersey College will be selecting one student from each campus to participate in Nursing Mission Trip (the “Mission”) to be held between May 3, 2020 and May 9, 2020. Each campus of Jersey College will be selecting one student enrolled in any track of a Professional Nursing Program. The selection committee will also select two alumni to participate as mentors to the nursing students.
- 2. Travel Expenses:** Jersey College will cover the expenses for i) Roundtrip flights to Luis Muñoz Marín International Airport in Puerto Rico; ii) roundtrip transfers between Luis Muñoz Marín International Airport and the housing in Puerto Rico; iii) housing to be provided in Puerto Rico; iv) any breakfast and dinners to be provided at the housing in Puerto Rico. Jersey College will not be responsible for any costs associated with transportation between participant’s home and their local airport and will not pay for any food purchased at a restaurant or grocery store during the Mission or enroute to Puerto Rico.
- 3. Travel Details and Lodging Details:** The 2020 Jersey College Nursing Mission will take place at Hospital General Castañer located in Castañer, Puerto Rico. Castañer, Puerto Rico is approximately 2.5 hours from Luis Muñoz Marin Airport. Participant must be able to tolerate driving through mountainous terrain in a 12 to 15 passenger van. Participants and chaperones will all stay in a house rented by Jersey College in Castañer, Puerto Rico. Participant will likely be required to sleep in a room with at least one other participant. Participant room assignments will be determined by the chaperones. Roundtrip air travel to will be arranged by Jersey College on behalf of each participant, Jersey College will attempt to have participants fly together. Mission organizer will arrange for breakfast and dinner to be prepared for participants in the rental house, participants will be able to purchase lunches at the hospital. Mission organizer may arrange for participants and chaperones to eat at restaurants and for the group to purchase food at grocery stores.
- 4. Chaperones:** The following individuals will accompany the selected participants on this Mission trip. Mission Organizer: Arizbeth Ortiz, MSN, FNP, ARNP (Instructor at Jersey College in Fort Lauderdale) and Daisy Molina, MSN-Ed, RNC-LRN, LCL, CIME (Campus Director at Jersey College in Teterboro, NJ)
- 5. Itinerary:** The itinerary will be finalized by April 15, 2020. Applicants should expect to spend 7 to 8 hours per day at Hospital General Castañer. Remaining time will be spent at the rental house or at activities planned by the Mission Organizer. Mission Organizer will

attempt to have participants spend some time in Old San Juan before return flights depart on Saturday May 9, 2020.

6. **Application Dates:** The opportunity to apply for the Mission starts on February 10, 2020 at 12:00 p.m. and ends on March 8, 2020 at 12:00 p.m. (“Application Period”). All applications must be received on or before the time stated during the Application Period. Jersey College reserves the right to extend or shorten the Application Period at its sole discretion.
7. **Benefactor:** The Mission is being provided by Jersey College, 546 US Highway, Teterboro, NJ 07608. Any questions, comments or complaints regarding the Mission should be directed to Jersey College.
8. **Mission Rules:** The Mission is governed by these official rules (“Mission Rules”). By submitting an application, each applicant agrees to abide by these Mission Rules, including all eligibility requirements, and understands that selection of students/alumni to participate in the Mission, as determined by Jersey College and its agents, are final in all respects. Being selected as a participant in the Mission is contingent upon being compliant with these Mission Rules and fulfilling all other requirements set forth herein. The Mission is subject to all federal, state and local laws and regulations and are void where prohibited by law.
9. **Eligibility:** To be eligible for the Mission, applicants must be:
 - A legal U.S. citizen or resident;
 - Eighteen (18) years of age or older at the time when the Mission trip begins;
 - Enrolled as a student at Jersey College at the time of the applying and at the time the Mission participants are selected; or applicant must be a graduate from a Jersey College professional nursing program.
 - A student at the campus from which the applicant is applying for participation in the Mission or applicant must be a graduate from a Jersey College professional nursing program; and
 - In good academic, financial and other standing with Jersey College.
 - Student must be registered in one of the following courses on March 15, 2020: *NUR202, NUR203, NUR204, NUR205, NUR222, NUR223, NUR224, NUR225, NUR226*; or applicant must be a graduate from a Jersey College professional nursing program.
 - Student or alumnus must receive two signatures from Jersey College faculty signifying a recommendation to participate.
 - Student/alumnus must agree to adhere to Jersey College’s Code of Conduct and all rules as per the Student Handbook and Catalog during the Mission Trip.
 - Student/alumnus or must complete and sign the following form:
INDEMNIFICATION, WAIVER OF LIABILITY, RELEASE, COVENANT NOT TO SUE AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL CARE AUTHORIZATION AGREEMENT

Jersey College has the right to verify the eligibility of each applicant. Employees of Jersey College and their immediate families (spouse, parent, child, sibling and their respective spouses, regardless of where they reside) or those living in the same household (whether or

not related) of Jersey College, and their respective parents, affiliates, subsidiaries, mission suppliers, distributors and advertising and promotion agencies (collectively, “Related Parties”) are not eligible to participate in the Mission selection process. In addition, members of the Mission Selection Committees (as defined below) and their immediate families (spouse, parent, child, sibling and their respective spouses, regardless of where they reside) or those living in the same household (whether or not related) are not eligible to apply or be selected to participate in the Mission. Individuals are limited to submitting one (1) application for the Mission.

10. **How to Apply:** Eligible individuals can apply for the Mission by submitting a “2020 Jersey College Mission Trip Application” which includes a concise essay (the “Essay”). The Essay must be written on the following theme: “**As a Student/Alumnus of Jersey College, How Have You Demonstrated Jersey College values (PRIDE) through community service participation during and after your enrollment?**” The Essay should be between 500 and 1,000 words in length. The Essay must be typed and should be formatted with 12pt Times New Roman Font and single spacing. The Essay should be in a Microsoft Word document (or a compatible program) or PDF. Application submissions must be emailed to mission@jerseycollege.edu. Applications and The Essay may be checked by software for plagiarism, and any instances of plagiarism will result in automatic disqualification.
11. **Selection:** The “Selection Committee” will include the Chancellor, Vice-President, Provost, and Mission organizer. This committee will be responsible for reviewing each eligible application and selecting the participants for the Mission. Mission participants will be announced on or about March 15, 2020 on or about 1:00 PM EST. Announcement of Mission participation will be sent via email message or phone call to the selected participants. Each applicant is responsible for monitoring his/her email account for notifications and other communications. If a selected participant cannot be reached by Jersey College within five (5) days, using the contact information provided at the time of application, that participant shall forfeit their participation. If a selected participant fails to comply with these Mission Rules, that selected participant will lose their ability to participate in the Mission. In the event that an insufficient number of eligible applications are received (as determined by Jersey College), the Mission may be cancelled.
12. **Terms and Conditions May Apply:** Incidental expenses and all other costs and expenses which are not specifically listed as part of the Mission in these Mission Rules and which may be associated with the Mission, acceptance, receipt and use of all or any portion of the Mission are solely the responsibility of the respective selected participant. **ALL FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL TAXES ASSOCIATED WITH THE RECEIPT OR USE OF ANY BENEFIT ASSOCIATED WITH PARTICIPATION IN THIS MISSION TRIP IS SOLELY THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE WINNER.**

13. General Terms and Conditions: Students and alumni selected to participate in the Mission may not transfer the selection. No substitution is permitted. Jersey College and its respective parent, affiliate and subsidiary companies, agents, and representatives are not responsible for any typographical or other errors in the offer or administration of the Mission, including, but not limited to, errors in any printing or posting of these Mission Rules, the selection and announcement of any Mission participant. Any attempt to damage the operation associated with the Mission is unlawful and subject to possible legal action by Jersey College. Jersey College reserves the right to terminate, suspend or amend the Mission, without notice, and for any reason, including, without limitation, if Jersey College determines that the Mission cannot be conducted as planned or tampering or unauthorized intervention, technical failure or other cause beyond Jersey College's control corrupts the administration, security, fairness, or integrity of the Mission. In the event any tampering or unauthorized intervention may have occurred, Jersey College reserves the right to void suspect applications at issue. Jersey College and its respective parent, affiliate and subsidiary companies, agents, and representatives, and any telephone network or service providers, are not responsible for incorrect or inaccurate transcription of application information, or for any human error, technical malfunction, lost or delayed data transmission, omission, interruption, deletion, line failure or malfunction of any telephone network, computer equipment or software, the inability to access any website or online service or any other error, human or otherwise. Failure of Jersey College to enforce any provision of these Mission Rules shall not constitute a waiver of that provision.

14. INDEMNIFICATION AND LIMITATION OF LIABILITY: BY APPLYING TO PARTICIPATE IN THE MISSION, EACH APPLICANT AGREES TO INDEMNIFY, RELEASE AND HOLD HARMLESS JERSEY COLLEGE AND ITS PARENT, AFFILIATES AND SUBSIDIARY COMPANIES, ADVERTISING AND PROMOTIONAL AGENCIES, AND ALL THEIR RESPECTIVE OFFICERS, DIRECTORS, EMPLOYEES, REPRESENTATIVES AND AGENTS FROM ANY LIABILITY, DAMAGES, LOSSES OR INJURY RESULTING IN WHOLE OR IN PART, DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY, FROM THAT APPLICANT'S PARTICIPATION IN THE MISSION AND THE ACCEPTANCE, USE OR MISUSE OF THE MISSION TRIP THAT APPLICANT MAY BE SELECTED FOR. JERSEY COLLEGE AND ITS PARENT, AFFILIATES AND SUBSIDIARY COMPANIES DO NOT MAKE ANY WARRANTIES, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, AS TO THE CONDITION, FITNESS OR MERCHANTABILITY OF THE MISSION. In addition, by participating, each applicant grants all copyright ownership of the Essay to Jersey College, as well as permission to post the Essay (or excerpts thereof) on Jersey College's website with applicant's name, and permission to post the Essay (or excerpts thereof) on all Jersey College social media platforms and any college marketing materials.
16. **Arbitration and Choice of Law:** Except where prohibited by law, as a condition of applying for the Mission, applicants agree that (1) any and all disputes and causes of action arising out of or connected with the mission, or any Mission selected for, shall be resolved individually, without resort to any form of class action lawsuit, and exclusively by final and binding arbitration under the rules of the American Arbitration Association and such arbitration shall be commenced exclusively in the County of Bergen in the State of New Jersey; (2) the Federal Arbitration Act shall govern the interpretation, enforcement and all proceedings at such arbitration; (3) judgment upon such arbitration award may be entered in any court having jurisdiction; and (4) to the exclusive jurisdiction of the State of New Jersey even if his/her residence is in another state or country and he/she would not otherwise be subject to such jurisdiction for the adjudication of any dispute hereunder or in connection herewith or with any transaction contemplated hereby or discussed herein. Under no circumstances will applicants be permitted to obtain awards for, and applicants hereby waives all rights to claim, punitive, incidental or consequential damages, or any other damages, including attorneys' fees, other than contestant's actual out-of-pocket expenses (i.e., costs associated with applying for the Mission), and applicants (or, if an eligible minor, his/her parent or legal guardian) further waives all rights to have damages multiplied or increased. All issues and questions concerning the construction, validity, interpretation and enforceability of the Mission Rules, or the rights and obligations of applicants and Jersey College in connection with the Mission, shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with, the substantive laws of the State of New Jersey, USA without regard to New Jersey choice of law rules.
